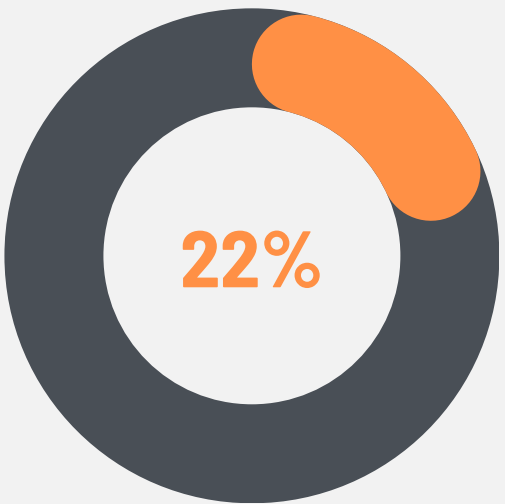


The Food Poverty Problem



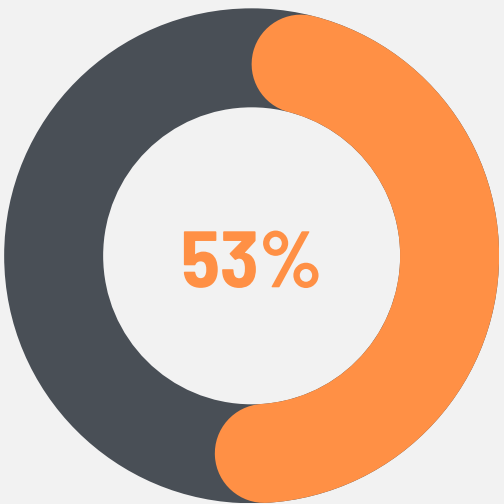
These Cost of Living Times

Even in a thriving borough such as Hackney, many residents face the harsh reality of food poverty. The rising cost of living has placed a significant burden on our community.



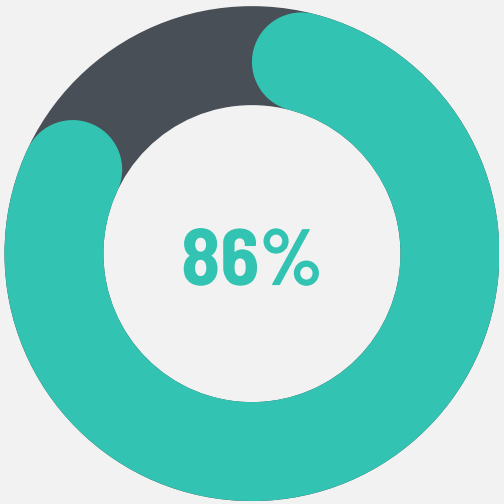
Skipping Meals

Nationally, 86% of food bank users struggle with extremely limited budgets, forcing them to make tough choices between essentials.





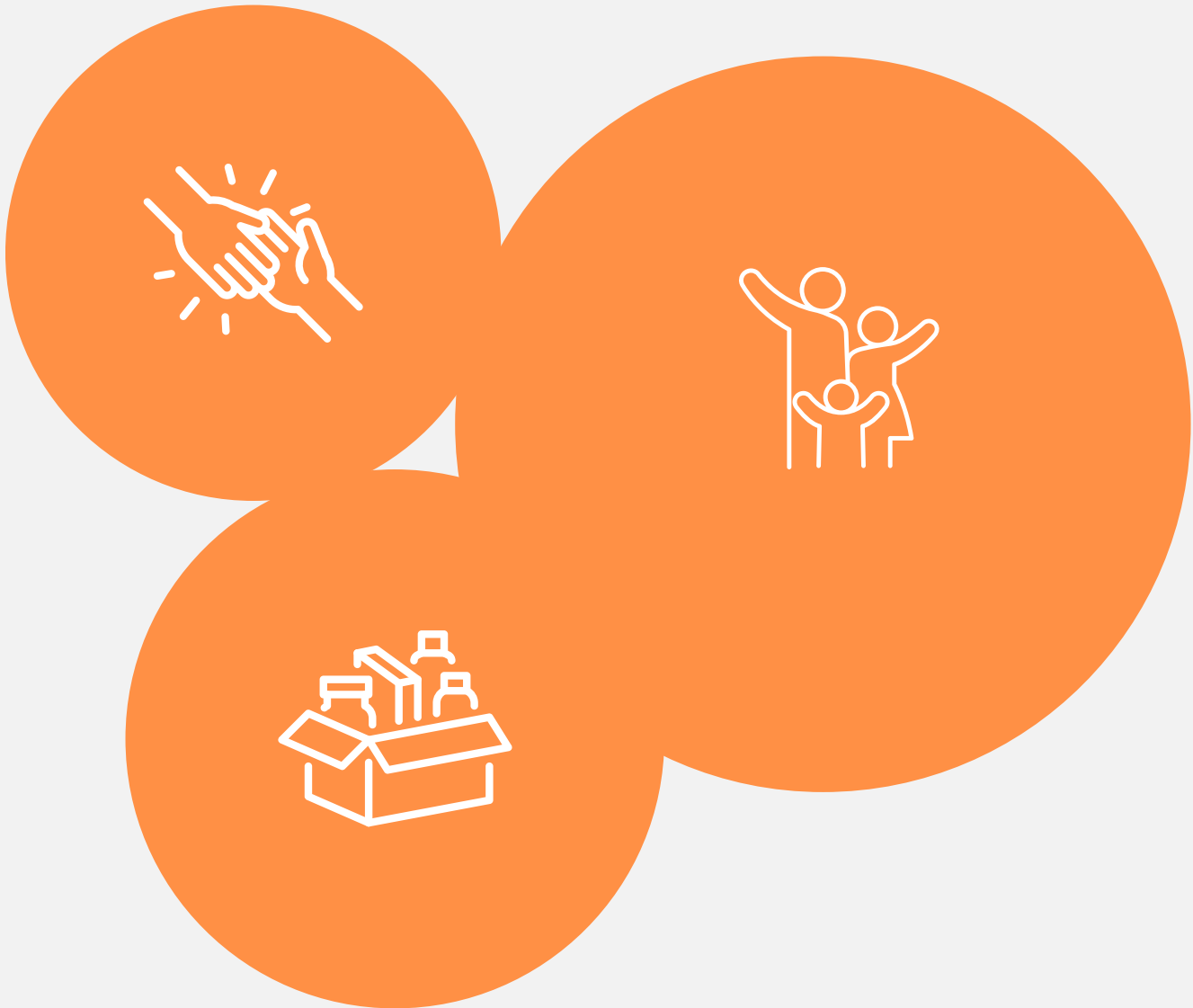
HOW HERC HAS HELPED SO FAR

H.O.P.E Morningside

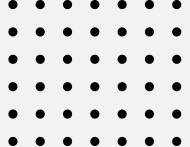
Supported H.O.P.E @ Morningside Community Centre who run a weekly food bank every Wednesday.

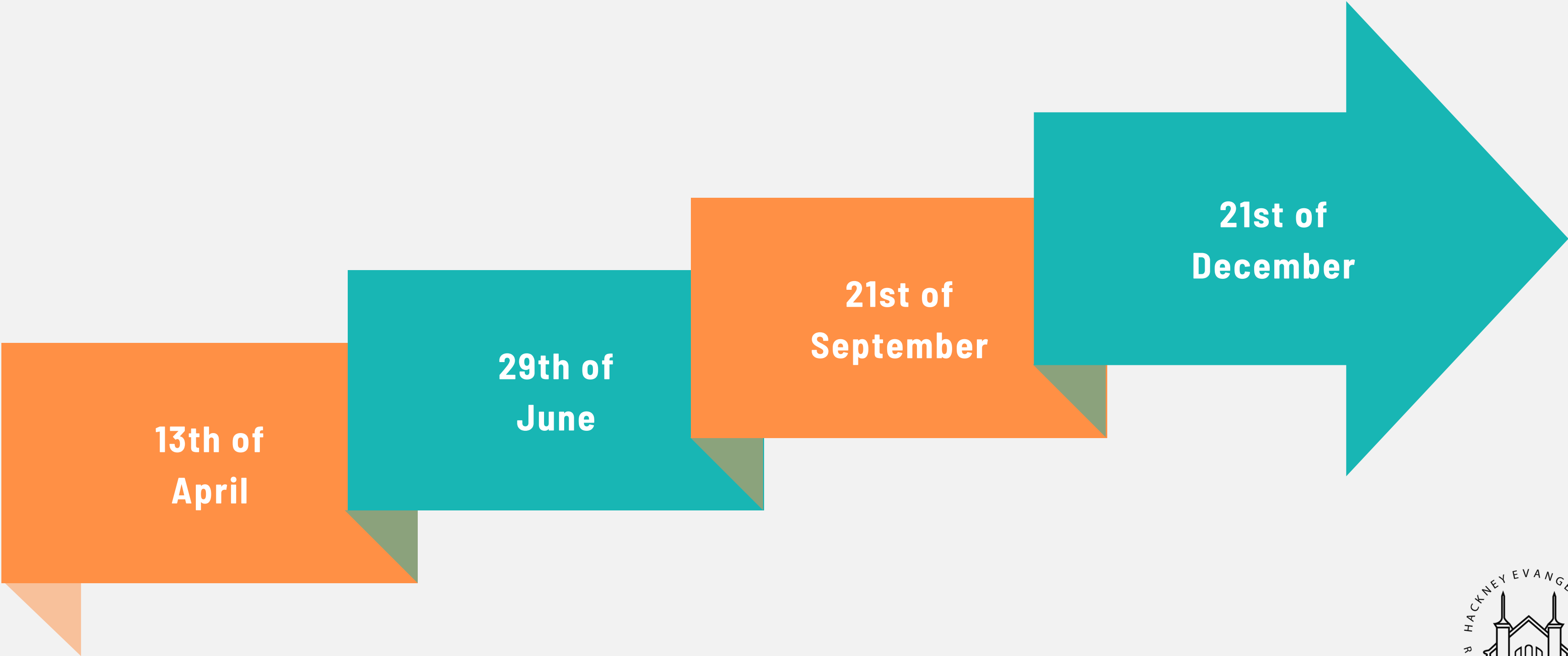

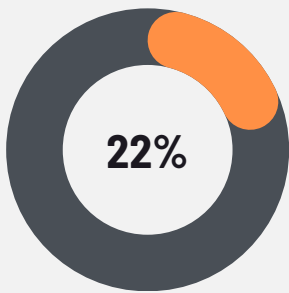

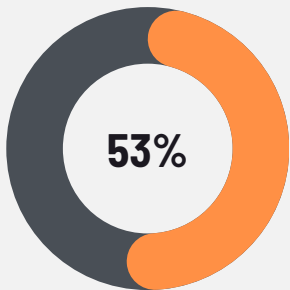
2024 FOODBANK DATES
